## ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Southern State Community College and Palmer College of Chiropractic

Course Education Requirements

January, 2006

The purpose of this agreement is to enhance the transition of Associate degree graduates from Southern State Community College into baccalaureate degree programs at Palmer College of Chiropractic. This agreement shall establish the conditions under which students from SSCC shall progress to senior or upper division status. NOTE: Students wishing to participate under the terms and conditions of this agreement must complete an Associate degree program at SSCC as well as meet all of Palmer College of Chiropractic admissions requirements.

Listed below is the recommended course of study to meet the prerequisite requirements needed to enter Palmer College of Chiropractic. Overall, 90 semester hours are required. (135 quarter hours) All prerequisite courses listed below must be completed with grade "C" or better. The minimum prerequisite and cumulative grade point average for entrance to Palmer College is 2.50 on a 4.0 grading scale. Completion of at least eight courses at SSCC is required as well as applying one year in advance of the intended start date.

Other course selections may be acceptable; however, please check with the admissions office before registering for classes other than those listed.
