

## OTHER INFORMATION

### ▪ **Non-reimbursable Costs**

Certain expenses will not be supported by Training Grant funds.

- equipment
- meals
- trainee wages
- training videos/CDs
- personal enrichment courses or other similar forms of education (philosophy, life enrichment, ethics, etc.)

### ▪ **Funding Limits**

Training Grant funds will support up to 75% of the total eligible costs of training, however, *the total amount of funds provided should not exceed \$650.00 per employee/trainee per year.*

### ▪ **College Credit Training**

Grant funds are limited to non-credit training.

### ▪ **Locations**

Training can be delivered on site at the company, on one of the college campuses, or elsewhere.

## WHY

Targeted Industries Training Grants are being made available to help companies improve their:

- Quality
- Productivity
- Training competitiveness
- Retention of workers
- Expansion of operations
- Development of new business
- Relocation/expansion in Ohio
- Combination of these goals

## HOW

The Ohio General Assembly appropriated Job Challenge program funds to the Ohio Board of Regents and the EnterpriseOhio Network to make Targeted Industries Training Grants available to EnterpriseOhio Network campuses to support training they provide to eligible companies.



## WHO

### Which Companies are Eligible for Training Grants ?

- **Manufacturing Employers**, particularly smaller companies with less than 100 employees. Other related companies on which manufacturers depend may also be eligible.
- **Any Employers** with a need to improve the computer skills of their workforce. This can range from the basics of word processing up to programming and other advanced topics.
- **Health Care Employers** play a significant role in Ohio's economy. This is the first year Targeted Industries Training Grants have been available to them. Most Health Care Employers are eligible, including for-profit, non-profit or not-for profit organizations. To qualify for financial support the Health Care employer must use employee training or related services to improve the organization's quality, customer service, productivity, competitive ability or operational excellence.



## HOW TO GET A GRANT

An eligible company and a representative from the Southern State Center For Business And Industry develop a training project together. They jointly submit a simple fill-in-the-blanks application to the Ohio Board of Regents. The Center For Business and Industry has all the required forms & related information.
