SSCC Patri-Tots in Wilmington scores fifth perfect inspection

The Patri-Tots Learning Center at Southern State Community College's North Campus in Wilmington has just earned its fifth 100-percent compliant state licensing inspection.

"I want to commend my staff for their continued dedication to our children and their families," said Karee Shaw, site administrator. "The fact that they earned this perfect rating during an unannounced visit while I was out of the office just proves the level of quality at which they continually operate."

In 2012, the center received a Two-Star Step Up To Quality (SUTQ) award from the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services. SUTQ is a voluntary, three-star quality rating system which helps parents identify early care and education programs that go beyond the minimum standards of licensing. Qualified teachers align their curriculum with the Ohio's Infant and Toddler Guidelines and Early Learning Content Standards. The centers are open weekdays from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. and have part- and full-time care options.
