PURPOSE OF THE SCHOLARSHIP

The purpose of the scholarship is to provide funds to one or more qualified students in order to assist them toward the completion his/her education at Southern State Community College. One (1) \$500 scholarship will be awarded. The number and amount of the scholarship will be based upon funding availability. Recipients will be notified after March 9th of the academic year.

ELIGIBILITY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP

- Scholarships are offered to students attending Southern State Community College.
- Limited to residents of Highland, Brown and Adams counties in Ohio and Bracken and Mason counties in Kentucky.
- A grade point average of 2.6 or above is required. Please attach an official transcript of your most recent enrollment.
- Student must be registered as a full-time student (12 or more credit hours).
- Student must have an art focus by enrolling in at least one art course per quarter.

Applications will not be processed unless they are complete and received by February 15th. A complete application includes the following:

1. A typed or printed application
2. A grade transcript, which includes a cumulative grade point average.
3. A one page Artist Statement.
4. Have 3-5 original works of art available to bring to an interview upon request

WHERE TO APPLY

Applications will be available in the Financial Aid Office in Hillsboro and on the Southern State web site at www.sccc.edu. Select "Current Student", then select "Financial Aid", then select "Scholarships", select "Foundation Scholarships" and then Lake Waynoka Civic Club and the Ohio Plein Art Society Art Scholarship". Applications may be requested by phone by calling 1 (800) 628-7722 or (937) 393-3431, extension 2610. Applicants assume all the responsibilities for the following:

1. Obtaining a transcript from the high school or college last attended
2. Returning or following up to see that all parts of the application process have been sent:
