

Installing SSCC VPN



Tap Settings



← Tap Wi-Fi



← Switch to “ON” (if not already)

← When connected to the campus specific wireless (i.e. South, North, Central, or Fayette) Tap the Blue Arrow (this will need to be done for each campus you wish to access the wireless from)



← Switch Auto-Login to "OFF"

Go Back to the main Settings by tapping Wi-Fi Networks then settings at the top left side of your screen
