How to: Install QuickTime 7

This white paper will guide you through the installation process of QuickTime 7.

Step (1) Access Internet Explorer and Quicktime

To access the Internet Explorer, you will have to find the button labeled **Internet Explorer** and double-click it.

The icon looks like this:



Then, in your address bar, you will navigate to **http://www.quicktime.com/**.



After the QuickTime homepage loads, in the middle of the page you will see **Free Download**. Click on **Free Download**.



Once the QuickTime download page loads, click on **QuickTime Standalone Installer** located at the lower-right side of the page.



Now, a new page will load asking you for some information about you and your computer. Select either **QuickTime 7 for Windows 2000/XP** or **Quicktime 7**

for Mac OS X v10.3.9 or later depending on what type of system and Operating System you have installed.

(Note: QuickTime 7 cannot be installed on Windows 95/98/NT or ME)

Also, select the next two boxes if you would like Apple and QuickTime to send you news about related events, etc.

And finally, type in your email address in the designated field and click **Free Download Now** to start your download.

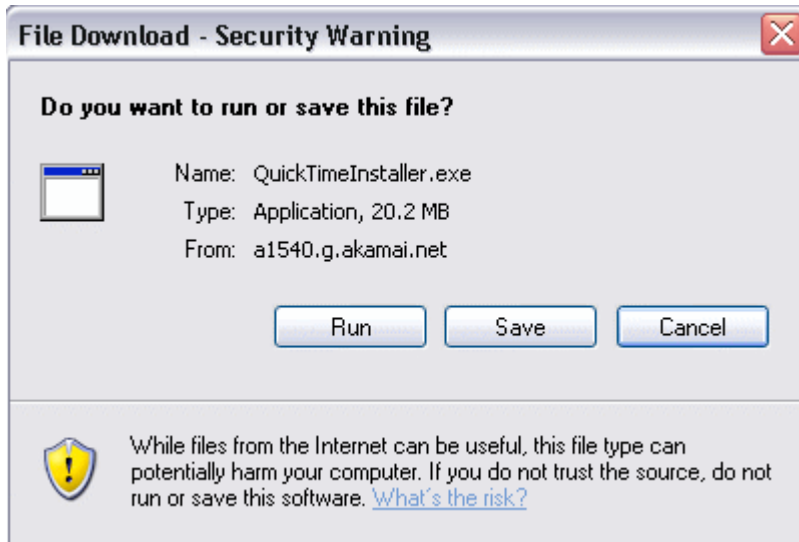

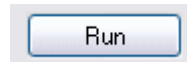

Step (2) Downloading and Installing QuickTime 7

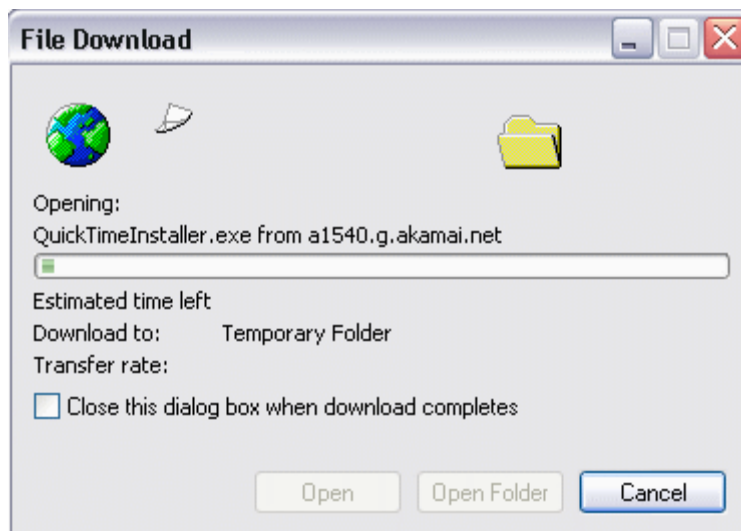
You will now receive a Confirmation page notifying you that you have entered in all necessary information and your download will automatically start. A *Save As* dialog box will also appear within 10 seconds (may vary depending on connection type and speed).



Choose **Run** to start downloading QuickTime 7.



Once the download begins, a box will appear that shows the progress of your download.

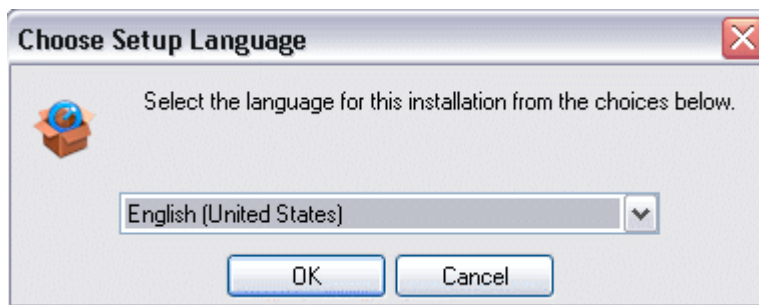


For Windows XP users:

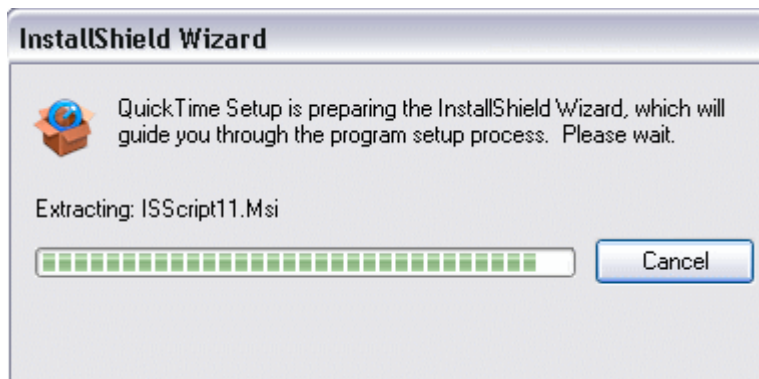
After the download is complete a *Security Warning* will appear asking you if you really want to run this software. Choose **Run**.



The Install Wizard will now be on your screen. The first box will ask you what language you would like to install QuickTime 7 in. Select your language and click **OK**.



The Install Wizard will now install QuickTime7.

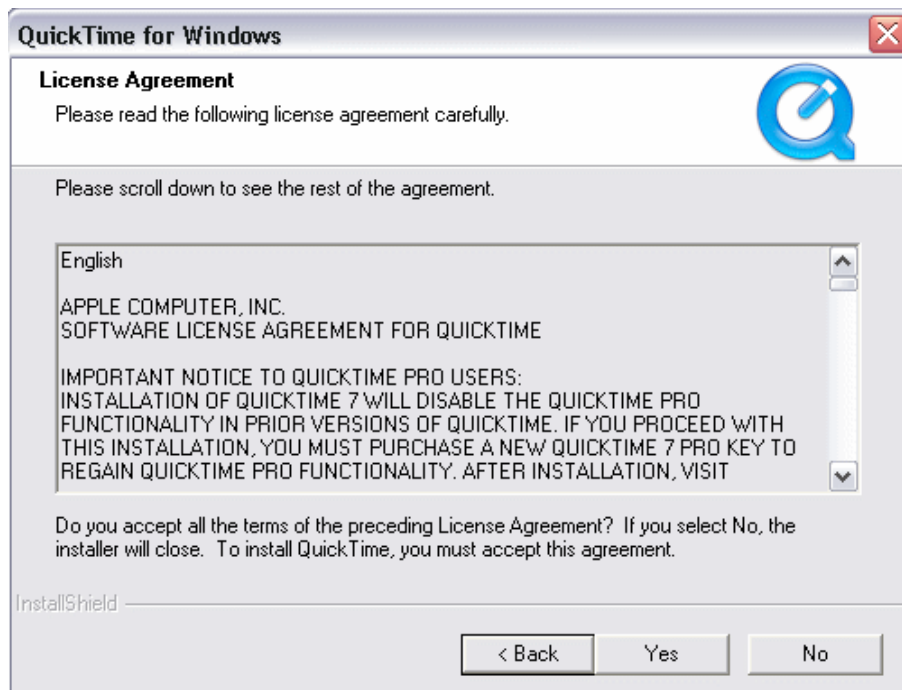


Step (3) Setup and Finish QuickTime 7

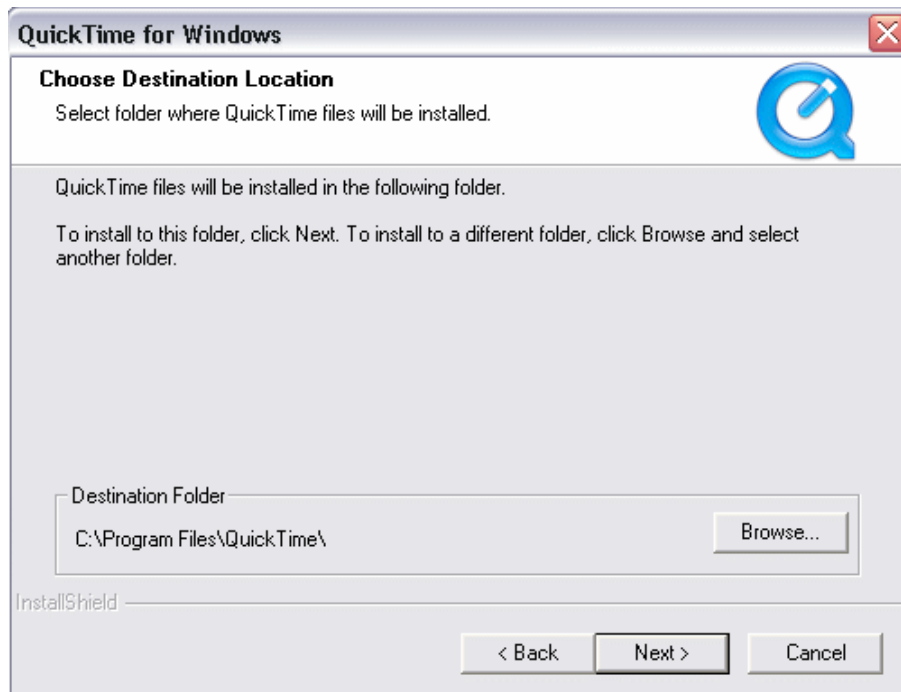
Next, you will see the Setup Wizard that will guide you through the setup process. Click **Next** to continue.



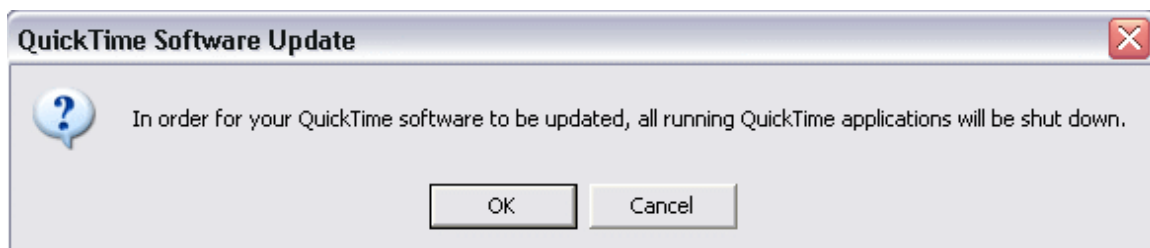
On the next page, choose **Yes** to agree with the license agreement.



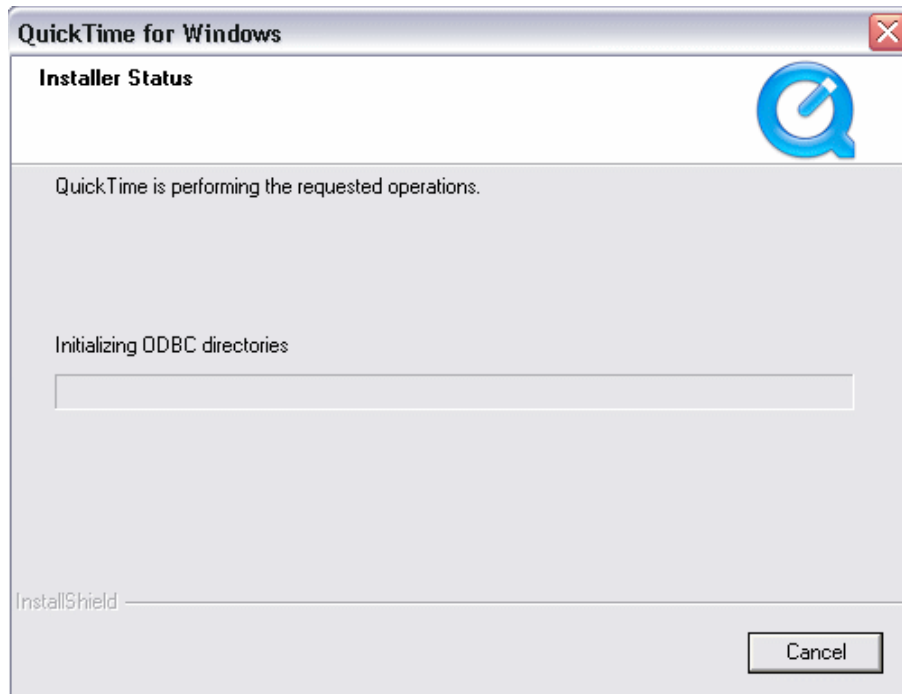
You will now be prompted to choose an installation directory. Notice there is already a default path (C:\Program Files\QuickTime\). Unless you need or want to change the path, choose **Next** to continue.



In order to proceed to the following steps, all open QuickTime applications will need to be shut down. A box will appear telling you that it will automatically do so. Click **OK**.



The installation process will now start.



Finally, once installation is complete, the next page will give you a confirmation of a successful installation and you will need to click **Finish** to complete the wizard. Enjoy!
