Making payments

All tuition and fees must be paid in full before registration is complete. Payments may be made in person, or by deposit in secure drop boxes which are located on each campus. Payment options available

A contractual **Deferred Payment Option** is available by placing a \$100 deposit and completing a Deferred Payment Option contract by the deadline dates listed in this brochure. Deferred Payment Options must be completed prior to each quarter. Payment of fees must be completed prior to registration for the next quarter.

Federal and state financial aid is available for those who qualify. By completing the Federal Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), eligibility is determined for a variety of federal and state financial aid programs. Student loans are available for all students who qualify. Eligibility is determined by completing the FAFSA. The freshman loan amount is \$3500 plus \$2000 for a total of \$5500 and the sophomore loan amount is \$4500 plus \$2000 for a total of \$6500. Additional loans may be available for independent students.
