

#### MONTHLY FINANCIAL REPORT

#### July 31, 2025

SSCC's mission is to provide accessible, affordable and high quality education to people in southern Ohio.

#### **Finance Dashboard Summary**

- Revenue was as than expected. However as of July 31, Fall 2025 enrollment was tracking -15% lower than Fall 2024. As of August 18, enrollment is -9% lower than Fall 2024. If that trend continues, we would miss the Fall 2025 tuition budget by \$290k.
- Expenses were 7% lower than expected and were 10% of the budget through 8% of the fiscal year.

#### Revenue (Exhibit 1)

There are no surprises this month.

- State Subsidy (State Share of Instruction [SSI])
  - o The FY26 budget for SSI is \$7.5 million, which is a +5.5% increase from FY24 actual.
  - o However based on legislative activity from Summer 2025, the SSI is expected to be \$7.4 million for FY26.
    - The fiscal year-to-date actual is up +1.2% from FY25 actual.
- Student Fees (Tuition and Fees)
  - The FY26 budget for tuition and fees is \$6.3 million, which is +3.9% increase from FY25 actual, which includes a budgeted 2% increase in all credit hours.
  - o The state authorized a \$10 increase in tuition, which would make the tuition budget \$6.3 million for FY26.
    - The fiscal year-to-date actual is up +10.6% increase from FY25 actual but this trend will not continue.
  - o For accounting purposes, Student Fees are recognized on the accrual basis at the registration / drop-add date for the entire term and based upon current fee and course schedule.
- Other
  - o The FY26 budget for other revenue is \$460k, which is a -10.0% decrease from FY25 actual.
    - The fiscal year-to-date actual is down -17.5% from FY25.

#### **Expenses (Exhibit 1)**

Through 8% of the fiscal year, expenses are 10% of the budget. If the spending patterns continue as they have in previous fiscal years, total expenses would finish the fiscal year within budget.

- Total Expenses
  - o The FY26 budget for total expenses is \$14.2 million, which is a +7.6% increase from FY25 actual.
  - The fiscal year-to-date actual is up +14.2% from FY25 actual.

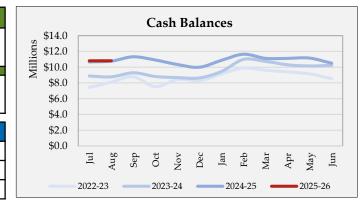
