SSCC Theatre is pleased to announce upcoming auditions for the spring production of Tracy Letts’ “August: Osage County.” Open to community members and students, auditions will be held 6:30 p.m. Friday, Dec. 5, in Room 203 on Southern State Community College’s Central Campus, 100 Hobart Drive, Hillsboro.

A vanished father. A pill-popping mother. Three sisters harboring shady little secrets. When the large Weston family unexpectedly reunites after Dad disappears, their Oklahoman family homestead explodes in a maelstrom of repressed truths and unsettling secrets. Mix in Violet, the drugged-up, scathingly acidic matriarch, and you've got a major new play that unflinchingly—and uproariously—exposes the dark side of the Midwestern American family. “August: Osage County” was the winner of the 2008 Tony Award for Best Play, and was awarded the Pulitzer Prize for Drama.
