Open to community members and students, auditions will be held 6:30 p.m. Friday, August 25, in the Edward K. "Death of a Salesman" revolves around the last days of failing salesman Willy Loman, who cannot understand his lack of success and happiness. Through a series of tragic soul-searching revelations of life with his wife, sons, and business associates, we discover how Loman's quest for the American Dream blinded him to those who loved him.
