

Policy Name: Nursing Transfer Credit Policy

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Policy

Students may request nursing credits by transfer from state approved or regionally accredited programs for the following courses in the Nursing Program. The course must have been successfully completed resulting in a grade of a 80% or higher. Additional nursing classes will not be considered for transfer credit.

NRSG 1200/PRAC 1200 Pathophysiology
NRSG 1300/PRAC 1300 Pharmacology

Procedure

1. The student must be accepted into either the Associate Degree Nursing Program or the Practical Nursing Program.
2. The student will request transfer for nursing credits by completing the Nursing Credit Transfer Form.
 - a. The Nursing Credit Transfer Form with required attachments may be submitted after a student has received official notification of acceptance to the appropriate Nursing program.
3. The courses for which the credit is being requested must have been completed within the past 24 months prior to entry into SSCC nursing courses. A grade of 80% or higher must have been achieved.
4. A review will be completed by Nursing faculty to assess and compare the content of previous course attended and the required curriculum of the appropriate Nursing Program. A transfer of credit will be approved when the learning outcomes of the SSCC Nursing Program course are components of the previous course completed.
5. When the review finds the course comparable, the Director of Nursing will forward a recommendation to accept transfer credit to the Records Office. Credit will be awarded upon completion of first week of Nursing program.
6. Student will receive written confirmation of acceptance/denial of the request to transfer credit by the director of nursing.
7. General education courses will be evaluated by the registrar per college policy.
