Earn a great salary – A career in Biotechnology typically pays well and a **college degree in this field** can **boost your earning potential**.

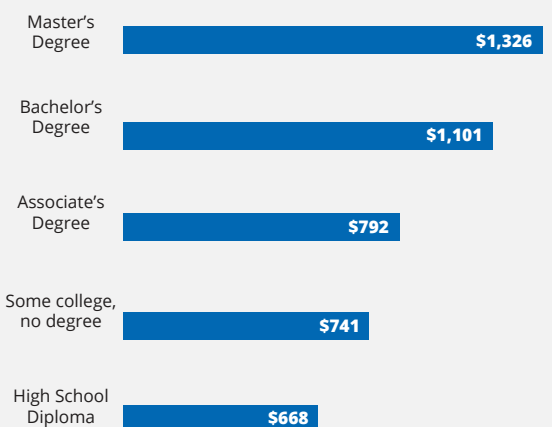
