ADMISSION CRITERIA FOR NURSING

Admission to Nursing requires the following minimum requirements. Completion of minimum requirements does not guarantee admission.

- Accepted SSCC student
- High school graduate or GED recipient
- Completed nursing application and responsibility form
- Prerequisite courses with a grade of C or higher (C- is not acceptable). Knowledge of prerequisite content is expected. If taken more than 5 years ago, it is strongly recommended that course be repeated.

- **CHEMISTRY (must meet at least one criteria)**
 - High school chemistry
 - CHEM 1120, Introduction to Chemistry

- **BIOLOGY (must meet at least one criteria)**
 - High school biology
 - BIOL 1040, Human Biology I
 - BIOL 1310, Principles of Biology I

- **ALGEBRA (must meet at least one criteria)**
 - High school algebra
 - Integrated Math I, II, III (medical math)
 - MATH 1116, Beginning Algebra
 - MATH 1118, Intermediate Algebra

- **Pre-entrance testing**
 - HESI Admission Assessment (A2) Exam with an average score of 75% or higher in Math and Reading Comprehension within 24 months of application. The scores of all categories will be considered during the ranking process.

PRE-ENTRANCE NURSING TESTING

- Testing is conducted at:
 - Central Campus (Hillsboro)
 - Brown County Campus (Mt. Orab)
- Required for **all applicants**, regardless of previous degrees
- Fee: **\$65 per attempt** (non-refundable)

HESI Admission Assessment (A2) Exam Information

The HESI A2 Exam consists of four academic exams, as well as a personality profile that identifies the individual applicant's learning style. Total testing time will be up to 2 hours and 40 minutes. The following subscales will be scored:

Section	Number of questions	Time allowed
Reading Comprehension	55 items	60 minutes
Basic Math Skills	55 items	50 minutes
Biology	30 items	25 minutes
Chemistry	30 items	25 minutes

- Maximum of **two attempts in a 12-month period**
- **Free** remediation is provided through Elsevier. If not already completed, a student should register for an account with Elsevier at the following link: <https://evolve.elsevier.com/cs/store?role=student>. Click “sign in” at top right of home page, then click ‘create account’ under the blue “sign in”. The student’s SSCC email should be used when an email address is requested.
