Ohio Guaranteed Transfer Pathways offer students wishing to pursue a career in the field of Business two different pathway options, summarized below. Students can review the Associate Business Degree Decision Guide with their academic advisor to help them better understand their options.

**Option 1.** The Guaranteed Associate of Arts (AA) or Associate of Science (AS) degree in Business is designed for students intending to transfer to a public bachelor's degree Business program upon completion of the associate degree. This pathway guarantees students that 60 credit hours will transfer into any public four-year institution in Ohio with junior standing and enable them to complete their bachelor's degree in Business in approximately 60 additional credit hours.

**Option 2**. Students may choose to earn an Associate of Applied Business (AAB) or Associate of Applied Science (AAS). These degrees allow graduates to enter the workforce immediately upon graduation. Students who earn an AAB or AAS have the option to earn a bachelor's degree in a Business-related field in approximately 60 additional hours. Alternatively, they may choose to pursue a bachelor's degree in Business; however, depending on the institutional program accreditation, this option will likely require more than 60 additional credit hours and students may not transfer at junior standing.

- A prerequisite such as College Algebra (TMM001) may be needed for a student to reach Calculus I (TMM005) or Business Calculus (TMM013). Students transferring to Miami University must take Calculus 1 (TMM005).
- It is recommended that an Arts and Humanities or Social and Behavioral Sciences course is also a diversity course.
