PURPOSE

The purpose of the College Credit Plus Program is to provide students in grades 7-12, who are intellectually and socially capable, the opportunity to earn college and high school graduation credit through successful completion of college courses.

CCP APPLICATION PROCESS

- Submit College Credit Plus Program application, high school transcript/academic record, state approved test scores, and ACT/SAT scores (if applicable) to the SSCC Records Office. **Summer Semester deadline is May 10 | Fall Semester deadline is August 2 | Spring Semester deadline is December 13**
- After SSCC receives the student's College Credit Plus Application, transcript or grade report, and acceptable test scores (if applicable) the records office will contact the student by mail with information on next steps in the application process.
- Students **MUST** score "college ready" in math OR English
- Once the student's application is completed and on file, all College Credit Plus applicants will receive written notification of acceptance or denial.

CCP GUIDELINES

1. Students enrolling in the program will be expected and required to perform at the same level as all other students. College Credit Plus students are subject to the same policies and procedures, academic practices, and grading standards as all other Southern State Community College students.
2. Students will receive high school graduation credit as well as college credit. Tuition, fees, textbooks, and materials are provided at public expense. All student record information will be shared with the student's home high school.
3. Students who do not complete a course (fail, withdraw or receive any non-completion grade) may be required to reimburse their school district the cost of the course that was not completed and the books associated with the course.
4. Students will be responsible for the payment of any course that they attempt to repeat that has already been passed successfully. (Students may repeat a course that was previously failed or withdrawn from).
5. Parents of students under 18 years of age need to be aware that all SSCC computers have free, unfettered access to the internet. Southern State Community College computers do not use any type of filtering software.
6. The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) applies to education records at all levels of education. At the point of becoming a Southern State student, FERPA rights become those of the student. Without written consent from the student, a dependent student's information cannot be disclosed even to the parent. However, under the rules of College Credit Plus, the college reserves the right to communicate student record information with appropriate official(s) of the home high school. **Information will not be released to parents without signed authorization from the student.**
7. SSCC will assign all CCP students an academic advisor. Students should see their academic advisor prior to registration of each semester.
8. College Credit Plus will not fund remedial courses in English 0099 or below, MATH 1106, 1116, 1118.
9. Students are permitted to participate in the CCP program during the summer, fall, and spring semesters.
10. The state of Ohio requires any male student between the ages of 18 and 26 to be registered with Selective Service to be eligible for in-state residency (for tuition purposes) at Ohio public colleges and universities. Male students who turn 18 while taking classes as a CCP student must register immediately for Selective Service or their residency status will be changed to out-of-state and they will be responsible for the additional out-of-state charges.
