

Math Placement Guideline

1. Entering students will be required to take the ACCUPLACER Elementary Algebra placement test.
2. Students must satisfy at least one of the indicators in a math level to meet the requirements for that level.
3. The ACCUPLACER Elementary Algebra score is just one possible criterion.
4. Once a CCP student has been admitted to the CCP Program, use these math guidelines to select a math course. Note: Math 1106, Math 1116, Math 1118, are not eligible for CCP funding.

2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High School Algebra I with a grade of C or higher • 26-39 on ACCUPLACER 	MATH 1106 – Pre Algebra MATH 1115 – Math for Business/Social Sciences
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 years of College Prep Mathematics with a grade of C or higher • 40-59 on ACCUPLACER 	MATH 1116-Beginning Algebra MATH 1135- Allied Health Math
4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 years College Prep Mathematics with a grade of C or better • 60 or above on ACCUPLACER 	MATH 1118 –Intermediate Algebra Math 1120 – Technical Math
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3 years College prep Mathematics with a grade of C or better • 90 or above on ACCUPLACER 	MATH 1160 –Conceptual Statistics
5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3-4 years of College Prep Mathematics with a grade of B or higher • 90 or above on ACCUPLACER • ACT score of 22 or SAT 520 	MATH 1141- College Algebra MATH 1124- Finite Math
6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4-5 years of College Prep Mathematics, including Trigonometry with grades at the A or B level. • ACT score of 26 or above 	MATH 2221- Calculus

These courses are considered College Prep Math Courses:

Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, Advanced Math, Trigonometry, Pre-Calculus and Calculus.
