	 count as a grade. Tim said that in some areas certifications are move valued than a degree. Mike said that he believes the COMP TIA exam should be required for the course. Dr. Montgomery talked about the mini-dome project and the Esports program and told the committee that our program enrollment numbers are up. Dr. Montgomery talked about the relationship with Connections in Wilmington. Greg talked about the courses being taught in their facility and about their relationship with Southern State Community College. Dr. Montgomery said that some of our students asked about a meet and greet type of event with advisory committee members. Brian P. said the University of Cincinnati hosts an event where perspective employers can meet students and see some of their projects. George said AWS, MPA compliance, moonshine process, and workflow analysis should be included in the curriculum. Jerry said we need to look at cyber certification and that ITIL, Six Sigma, and NIST for cyber, should be welcome to take a tour of the GE facility and suggested we look at being involved in the Pike Science Alliance.
