INSTRUCTIONS: Complete and submit this form to the Financial Aid Office. Your 2023-2024 financial aid usage will be reviewed and to determine your eligibility for **Subsidized and/or Unsubsidized loan money for Summer Term**. If you have reached the annual loan limit, you will not be eligible to receive additional loan funding for the Summer term. You will be notified by mail once a determination is made. To receive Federal Student Loans, you must be enrolled **at least 6 credit hours (courses must be required for your academic program) and meet all other federal financial aid eligibility requirements including Satisfactory Academic Progress.**

Annual Subsidized (Sub) and Unsubsidized (Unsub) Loan Limits**Dependent Student**

- Freshman (0-29 Credits earned) up to \$5,500 (\$3,500 Sub and \$2,000 Unsub)
- Sophomore (30+ Credits earned) up to \$6,500 (\$4,500 Sub and \$2,000 Unsub)

Independent Student

- Freshman (0-29 Credits earned) up to \$9,500 (\$3,500 Sub and \$6,000 Unsub)
- Sophomore (30+ Credits earned) up to \$10,500 (\$4,500 Sub and \$6,000 Unsub)

Information for Summer Students that are Pell Eligible: (you do not need to return this form if you are planning to use Pell grant funds for Summer Term.)

- A student who has been **full-time** for the Fall and the Spring Semester **must be enrolled in a minimum of 6 credit hours to be considered for the Pell Grant.**
- A student who has been **less than full-time** for the Fall and the Spring Semester can be enrolled in less than 6 credit hours to be considered for the Pell Grant.
- Pell will be automatically moved to Summer Term if you have remaining eligibility.
