- Apply for admission and be accepted to SSCC for the Summer Semester prior to submitting the scholarship application.
- Be graduating from a high school or vocational school for the current academic year.
- Have a cumulative high school grade point average of at least 2.75 at the end of the first semester of senior year.
- Submit a high school transcript with this application by the deadline listed above.
- Highly recommended that you submit the 2023/2024 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.gov. (not required)
- Register for Summer 2024 classes at Southern State Community College (registration begins February 21, 2024).
- Scholarship will pay up to **six credit hours of tuition** for the summer 2024 semester only.
- Course fees, books, and other miscellaneous fees are not covered by the scholarship.
- Applicants will be mailed a final decision letter about the Super Start Scholarship.
