Duration

Internships are offered during the fall semester, August to December. Departments have the option to retain a student for a second semester (spring) if both parties are agreeable. Exact starting and ending dates will be arranged between the intern and the supervisor. Interns are expected to work 15-20 hours per week unless otherwise specified.

Compensation

Most internships are compensated at a rate of \$10.00 per hour.

Eligibility

Any full-time student who is currently enrolled at an institution of higher education with a GPA of at least 2.50 is eligible to apply for the intern program.

How to Apply

All students are hired through the Southwest Ohio Council for Higher Education's (SOCHE) SOCHEIntern program. Each application must apply through SOCHEIntern and include a resume to be considered complete.
