

2024 Changes to the Title IX Regulations: What Campuses Need to Know Now

Description: In March 2021, the Biden administration issued an executive order that called on the U.S. Department of Education (ED) to review and revise the Title IX regulations to ensure educational environments that are free from discrimination on the basis of sex. In July 2022, ED issued a draft of its proposed rule. The following September, ACE—along with nearly 240,000 other interested stakeholders—submitted comments. ED announced on April 19 that it had issued its long-awaited final rule, which is set to take effect on August 1, 2024.
